Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation grants pay for indirect costs?

A: ALSF funds cannot be used to pay indirect costs.

Q: Are appendices accepted by ALSF?

A: Appendices are acceptable for Innovation and Program Infrastructure categories only if they are crucial to the understanding of the application. Appendices for Young Investigator applications and excessive appendices will not be accepted. Appendices are included in the 10MB limit.

Q: Should the mentor's bio-sketch be included in the Young Investigator and 'A' Award applications?

A: Yes. Please include the mentor's bio-sketch as well as the mentoring plan and letter of recommendation.

Q: If I have already been funded by ALSF, can I reapply for additional funding?

A: Program Infrastructure Awards may apply for an additional two years of funding provided the institution is willing to monetarily support the program (ALSF will match funds from the institution for two years up to \$62,500/year for the program). Innovation Awards may apply for an additional one year of funding through the regular grant submission and competitive review process. Young Investigators are not eligible to reapply.

Q: What if I have not received my letter of approval for animal and/or human subjects?

A: In the appropriate sections note that the letters are pending and when they are expected to be approved. ALSF will hold funds if the proposal is funded until approval letters are submitted.

Q: I am having trouble logging back in to an application I have already started.

A: Close the internet (browser), open it again and login. If problem persists call the office: 610-649-3034.

Q: Does Alex's Lemonade Stand fund psychosocial research?

A: At this time, ALSF does not fund psychosocial aspects of pediatric cancer research in our medical grant program. However, please see our Nurse Researcher categories for more information.

Q: What does ALSF require from my institution if this proposal gets funded?

A: If funded, ALSF requires signed grant conditions, any animal/human subjects approval letters, proof of institutions not-for-profit status, other support document and a certificate of insurance with ALSF listed as an additionally insured (for self-insured institutions, a letter of indemnification will suffice). ALSF will also require a progress report and a final report.
