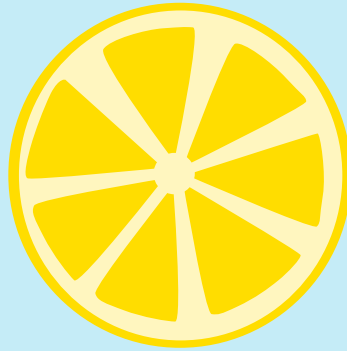


Childhood Cancer

Every day in the United States, **47 children, ages 0-19, are diagnosed with cancer.**



1,000

Every year, an estimated 400,000+ new cases of cancer affect children worldwide. **That's over 1,000 new kids affected every day.**



Childhood cancer is the **leading cause of death** by disease in children under the age of 19 in the U.S.



Childhood cancer survivors are **twice as likely to suffer chronic health conditions.**

One in 285 children in the U.S. will be diagnosed with cancer by the time they are 20 years old.
